A family dog went from feeling fine, to being completely blind in just hours and the problem could be in the water.

After Jason Terrell's pet dachshund got sick and went blind, the vet thought the problem could be a brain tumor.

But the Terrell's decided to test her food and water.

The food was fine, but the water test results showed a level of arsenic four times higher than normal.

The family lives on county road 7530 near Indiana and they use well water.

So, Terrell decided to test himself.

After results came back three times higher than the normal level, he knew something had to be done.

"They decided that the first thing we needed to do was remove the exposure so we're getting a filtration system put on the house and second they're going to come and do a study of all the well water in the area," said Terrell.

Terrell's wife and two daughter's just got their test results back today.

All three tested higher than the normal level of arsenic.
