### Expert Warns of Oil Effects

As the cleanup near Lake Alan Henry continues, environmentalists warn of the effects the oil could have on wildlife and even us.

Dr. Ron Kendall studies the toxic effects oil has on our health.

He says fish and other wildlife could already be feeling those repercussions, but he says it's likely the oil will be contained to the point we won't be affected.

"The key is the dose makes the poison, so the lower we can keep the oil from getting any access to the lake the better and that's why I think all the effort's being expended to try to stop the oil," Kendall says.

Kendall says it shouldn't take longer than a few weeks to complete the cleanup.

In all, he estimates about 6,000 gallons of oil is in the Brazos river.
